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## Notice of Construction – Hyde Park/Linwood

CINCINNATI – The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) will begin constructing new controls at two of its combined sewer overflow (CSO) outfalls in the Cincinnati neighborhoods of Hyde Park and Linwood in late March 2023. The project is expected to be completed in March 2024, pending weather and field conditions.

MSD's contractor, Howell Contractors, will construct a new diversion chamber, gate chamber, sluice, and gate at CSO 83, located in the vicinity of 3939 Erie Avenue, and at CSO 472 located in the vicinity of 4786 Beechmont Avenue. The purpose of the project is to reduce sewer overflows into Duck Creek and an unnamed tributary of the Little Miami River.


Construction work will generally occur weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Some weekend work may be needed.

Although no traffic impacts are anticipated, typical construction-related disturbances such as noise, dirt, and vibrations should be expected.
